# **Brazos County Voter Registration FAQ**

# **Prior to Registration**

#### Can I register to vote if I'm not 18 yet?

Yes. You must be at least 17yrs and 10 mnths old and will be 18 on Election Day

#### Do I need to be a U.S. citizen to register to vote?

Yes. You must be a naturally born or fully naturalized U.S. citizen

#### Do I have to register for each election?

No, once you are registered you do not need to re-register unless you move to another county, but please remember to update your information with your registration form whenever you move.

## What type of pen can I use to fill out my Voter Registration form?

When filling out your application, use **Black** or **Blue** pen.

## When is the Deadline to register or change my registration information?

The deadline for registering or updating your information is 30 days before Election Day, in order for it to be effective for that election.

## Do I need to re-register if I've moved?

Yes, if you have changed your address, changed your name, or need to change your political party, you must re-register.

## Do I have to include my gender or my phone #?

These boxes are optional. However, it may be useful to provide a phone number in case there are questions about your application (spelling error, illegible, etc.)

#### What if I don't have a driver's license, personal ID or social security number?

You can still register to vote, but you must submit proof of identification when presenting yourself for voting or with your mail-in ballots, if voting by mail.

#### I live in a dorm, what do I put down as my addresses?

If you live in a dorm, place your Dorm name and Room # as your residence address. For the mailing address, use whatever address you use to receive mail. This does not have to be in the same county you are registering in. As an example:

Residence Address: Hullabaloo Hall # 100, College Station, TX 77840

Mailing Address: 123 Alphabet Road, Houston, TX 99999

# What does "county of former residence" mean on the registration form?

If you are registering for the first time or changing your address to vote in Brazos County, you must list your previous city and county of residence (what city and county you lived in before moving to College Station/Bryan).

## What if I messed up on my registration form?

Simply cross a single line across your mistake and write <u>within</u> the box where the mistake was made, above or below your mistake.
